National Updates

- Federal interagency MOU on rapid response to invasive mussels in western waters is working through the clearance process among DOI, USFS, and USACE.
- Final report of Safeguarding the West in progress. Look forward to transitioning focus to collective implementation of QZAP 2.0.
- In Department clearance process to release DOI's Draft Invasive Species Strategic Plan for public comment.

National Updates

- Inter-Agency Agreement (5 years)
 - Funding for Watercraft Inspection and Decon classes (PSMFC) and western Watercraft Inspection and Decon database (CPW)
 - Signatories Lead: FWS
 - BLM, BOR, NPS
 - Goal of \$250K annually across 4 bureaus
 - Anticipated awards end of Fiscal Years

Funding Updates – FY2020

- <u>State ANS Plan Grants</u> (all regions)
 - Funding opportunity F20AS00034
 - All pre proposals due to Don MacLean by June 26th. All packages in GS with regional coordinators by Aug 1st.
 - Increased for 2020 (~\$89,200 per applicant)
- <u>QZAP funds</u> (Region 2)
 - Funding opportunity in process.
 - Increased to \$2.0M for 2020
 - Containment, prevention, outreach, early detection, research

100th Meridian Initiative' funds (Region 6) Not this year.

New Grants System



- Transparent, consistent, documented process.
- All DOI bureaus are transferring to this system.
 live now Fish & Wildlife Service
 - October 13, 2020 National Park Service
 - December 7, 2020 Bureau Indian Affairs, Bureau Land Management, Bureau Reclamation, U.S. Geological Survey
- New grants still apply thru Grants.gov
- Modifications, time extensions, reporting thru GS
