
Boat Inspection Program growth

2020 - Highest year for inspections <u>EVER!</u> ...also dealt with 25 watercraft with mussels*

- Opened March 15th
- Cle Elum
- Eastbound I-90 ...boats heading into the Columbia River Basin from the west.
- Exit 80 WA DOT Bullfrog Maintenance Yard
- Nice, Short, <u>Safe</u>, Loop
- 2-year Pilot Project generously funded by Bureau of Reclamation.
- Operate March October



WA Station Stats as of June 1, 2021

- 11,978 inspections
- 3,594 last on positive waters
- 79 Plant decons
- 51 Standing Water decons
- 18 Mussel boats
